

## 2020年中文學校聯誼會光輝十月比賽實施辦法 2020 WMACS Glorious October Competition

### Purpose:

In the form of competition, to encourage students who attended Washington area Chinese schools, which are part of the Washington Metropolitan Association of Chinese Schools (WMACS), to understand more about the knowledge of Taiwan including geography, culture, history, arts and people.

### Time:

- October 10th, 2020 12:45pm - 2:30pm

### Location:

Remote/Online

### Organizer:

### Eligibility:

All students currently registered to WMACS's member schools

### Registration:

1. Each student must sign up for him or herself. [Please register here](#). There are no limits on numbers of students can participate per school.
2. Registration deadline is October 4th, 2020, 11:59pm.

### Competition Groups:

1. Elementary
2. Middle & High School
3. <Optional> to be announced after registration deadline

### Competition Rules:

1. Competition questions will come from <http://biweekly.huayuworld.org/index/2016/759> AND from principals, WMACS advisors.
2. All competition must register prior to the registration deadline in order to receive a Webex invitation link to participate.
3. The competition will be conducted using Kahoot

- a. All students must login to the Webex meeting 15 minutes (at 12:45pm) before the competition start time (at 1pm).
- b. Competition during is roughly 20 minutes
- c. Competition consist of answering 30 multiple choice questions in Kahoot
- d. Competition winners will be determined by the Kahoot scores.  
Group/Kahoot host will present the winners to judges to formally announce the winners.
- e. If there are more than 1 winner with the same score in Kahoot, all the students with the same Kahoot score will be going to round 2. Otherwise, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners will be determined by the Kahoot score.
  - i. If round 2 occurs, round 2 will be conducted in Webex. Students will be entering their answers in the Webex chat.
  - ii. Round 2 is the sudden-death round. The 1st corrected answer is the 1st place. The 2nd corrected answer is the 2nd place. The 3rd corrected answer is the 3rd place.
  - iii. Competition instructor will read out the question slowly, students can type their answers in Webex chat anytime when the instructor starts reading.
- f. At the end of the competition, all participated students will be entitled to the prize drawing. Anyone who left the Webex meeting prior to the end of competition will be disqualified for the drawing.

Prizes:

1. 1st place \$200; 2nd place \$150; 3rd place \$100.
2. All competition participants will receive a reward certificate

Others:

1. WMACS reserves the rights to alter the events rules with proper notification to all competition participants, this includes, but not limits to, online hosting tool change, adding the competition groups; as such.
2. WMACS president has the power to handle emergency situations occurring during the competition.
