How to Save a Chinese Text as a Graphic File (e.g., a GIF file)

Method 1: Use Paint

(Start/All Programs/Accessories/Paint)

- 1. Press "Print Screen" or "PrtSc" button after typing Chinese characters.
- 2. Open Paint, paste the image.
- 3. Use on the tool bar to select the characters.
- 4. Right Click, use "Copy to..." to save it to a new file (save as type: "Monochrome Bitmap" or *.bmp).
- 5. From File/Open, select the file you just saved (when prompted: "Save changes to untitled?", choose "No"), the cropped image will appear.
- 6. Save <u>again</u> (File/Save as...) in *.GIF to get a smaller-size file.

Method 2: Use MS Photo Editor, if loaded (Start/All Programs/Microsoft Office Tools/Microsoft Photo Editor)

- 1. Press "Print Screen" or "PrtSc" button after typing Chinese characters.
- 2. Open MS Photo Editor, choose "Edit/Paste as New Image".
- 3. Use on the tool bar to select the characters. Right click, select "Crop".
- 4. Save as *.<u>GIF</u> to get a smaller-size file.
